#### Directions:

From the South, take I-93 to I-89 and Exit #9 in Warner. Go West on Route 103 about 25 miles to the Sunapee Circle and then 1 mile further to Harding Hill Road.

From the North, I-89 to Exit 12A in George's Mills. Go South on Route 11 to Route 103B just beyond the blinker in Sunapee. Then, 4 miles to the Sunapee Circle on Route 103 (entrance to Mt. Sunapee). Turn right on 103 and go 1 mile to Harding Hill Road. Look for EFTA arrows.
